Analysis of Findings

We learned that all customer segments feel that there needs to be more done to improve environmental sustainability including promotion or outreach for donating to causes in general, maintenance, and credibility. Most people in all customer segments are hesitant to donate because of the law of accountability (the biggest issues encountered when donating) and people want more transparency from charities and organizations. Although most interviewees had weak trust for these types of organizations, we did learn about organizations that our customer segments trust: Team Sea, Sierra Club, & TerraCycle. All customer segments (Gen Z, Gen X, and Millenial) look at social media, affiliates, impact, and what percentage of donations goes toward the actual cause when deciding if a cause is credible/accountable.

We also learned that as our interviewees increased in age, they were more likely to donate using money rather than time. Most interviewees in the Gen X customer segment prefer to donate with money rather than ad/time-based donating as they are busier and have more resources compared to other customer segments. We should think about focusing our customer segment to include only Gen Z and Millennials with minimal resources (money), but available time. All interviewees in customer segments Millennial and Gen Z would be open to ad-based donating.

From these findings, we will better position ourselves by using social media to our advantage to help eliminate the issue of lack of credibility/accountability. Transparency will also be increased by providing all distributions and percentage breakdowns of donations. We will also provide an easy user interface that allows for an opt-in subscription of your choice so you can be alerted of new causes in need. In addition, we will offer ad-based and regular donations to appeal to all customer segments.
